2020-2021 ANNUAL REPORT

Dear Penn Yan Community,

2020-2021 was a year of flexibility and persistence at Penn Yan Public Library. Staff and the Board of Trustees continuously adapted services to increase equity of ac-



cess to library materials and resources for isolated patrons.

Late fees were eliminated on most items at the onset of the pandemic. Staff continued to deliver programs and services virtually, in take-home kits, in on-site pod groups, and outside in good weather. An expanded e-mail newsletter reaching 1,144 subscribers was implemented. The number of borrowable WIFI Hotspots was tripled to 18 and

check-outs increased by 500%. The size of the Southern Tier Library System e-book collection was increased by 8.5%. Additionally, patrons can now use their StarCat cards to borrow e-books, e-audiobooks and e-magazines from partnering Pioneer and Finger Lakes Library Systems. Staff have added 138 new videos for all ages to the Penn Yan Public Library YouTube channel. Onsite, the Heating Ventilation Air Conditioning project



was finished along with the addition of air filtration and the reconfiguration of furnishings to make the Library seating areas more spacious and comfortable.
