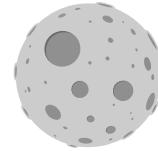

OUTDOOR TODDLER DANCE PARTY

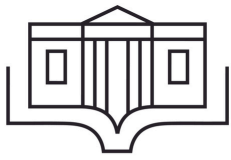
Put on your dancing shoes and boogie along to stories and songs! This program is held outdoors on the Main St. side of the library and will be canceled in the event of inclement weather.
